Truth

Our ReconciliACTION plan begins with truth. Nous recognizes that the history we may have been taught is incomplete; listening and learning from the stories of Indigenous Peoples in Canada, past and present, is integral to our individual and collective reconciliation journey.

Respect

We recognize that Canada is a country whose land has for time immemorial been stewarded by Indigenous Peoples and the deep and abiding connection many Indigenous people have for the land.

Friendship

We recognize that Indigenous culture and beliefs continue to thrive in Canada, and we value Indigenous worldviews. We recognize that friendship is a lasting relationship based on trust that is built over time and is an important pathway to reconciliation.

Our commitment

Through our actions, we commit to:

- Increasing our awareness of the experience, histories and stories of First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples through listening and learning from the stories of Indigenous Peoples, particularly in the areas in which we work Education, Government and Health
- Increasing the number of Indigenous employees working at Nous in Canada with a goal of 3% of total staff
- Working towards building open-ended relationships and friendships with First Nations, Métis and Inuit
 individuals and/or organizations with the view of identifying and supporting the achievement of
 mutual goals
